## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, further providing for permit for movement during 2 course of manufacture. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 4968(a.1)(3), (a.2)(4) and (b) of Title 7 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended October 8 24, 2012 (P.L.1473, No.187), are amended to read: 9 10 § 4968. Permit for movement during course of manufacture. 11 (a.1) General rule. -- An annual permit may be issued 12 authorizing movement on specified highways of: \* \* \* 13 14 aircraft refueling vehicles or vehicles and 15 combinations carrying [raw] milk, raw coal, flat-rolled steel 16 coils, steel slabs, hot ingots, a hot box, pulpwood and wood 17 chips, raw water or cryogenic liquid which exceed the maximum

weight specified in Subchapter C while they are in the course

- 1 of manufacture and under contract with or under the direct
- 2 control of the manufacturer, provided that they do not exceed
- 3 the maximum height, width or length specified in Subchapter B
- 4 unless they also qualify under paragraph (1), subject to the
- 5 provisions in subsection (a.2).
- 6 (a.2) Specifications.--
- 7 \* \* \*
- 8 (4) A combination of vehicles which is hauling [raw]
- 9 milk to or from a manufacturer may be permitted by the
- department and local authorities to move upon highways within
- 11 their respective jurisdictions 24 hours a day, seven days a
- 12 week, except during inclement weather as defined in
- department regulations, if the gross weight does not exceed
- 14 95,000 pounds and the weight of any nonsteering axle does not
- exceed 21,000 pounds. No permit may be issued for this type
- of movement upon an interstate highway. An application to the
- department for the movement of milk, except for raw milk,
- 18 must designate the route the applicant requests to use.

- 20 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 21 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 22 subsection:
- 23 "Bulk milk." The term shall mean milk, as defined in section
- 24 1 of the act of July 2, 1935 (P.L.589, No.210), referred to as
- 25 the Milk Sanitation Law, which is not transported in packages.
- "Condensed milk" and "evaporated milk." The term shall mean
- 27 <u>manufactured dairy products as defined in section 1 of the Milk</u>
- 28 Sanitation Law, which is not transported in packages.
- 29 "Hot box." Consists of an enclosure consisting of welded
- 30 steel plate chained to a semitrailer with a removable lid lined

- 1 with refraction for purposes of insulation and retention of
- 2 heat.
- 3 "Milk." Any of the following:
- 4 <u>(1) Bulk milk.</u>
- 5 (2) Cream.
- 6 (3) Plain or sweetened evaporated milk.
- 7 <u>(4)</u> Raw milk.
- 8 <u>(5) Skim or whole condensed milk.</u>
- 9 <u>(6) Skimmed milk.</u>
- 10 "Raw milk." Has the meaning given to it in the [act of July
- 11 2, 1935 (P.L.589, No.210), referred to as the] Milk Sanitation
- 12 Law.
- 13 Section 2. The General Assembly declares that the amendment
- 14 of 75 Pa.C.S. § 4968(a.2)(4) shall not affect the Department of
- 15 Transportation's requirements regarding the permit for the
- 16 movement of raw milk found at 50A on pages 83 and 84 of the
- 17 Department of Transportation's Publication 31.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
