AN ACT

Amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), entitled "An act establishing a uniform construction code; imposing powers and duties on municipalities and the Department of Labor and Industry; providing for enforcement; imposing penalties; and making repeals," further providing for exemptions for certain buildings as to automatic fire sprinkler system requirements.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 901 of the act of November 10, 1999
(P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code
Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
Section 901. Exemptions.
* * *
(g.1) Automatic fire sprinkler systems in use group R-3 and
<u>R-4 buildingsNotwithstanding any other provision of this act</u>
to the contrary, the fire safety requirements of the
International Building Code with respect to automatic sprinkler
systems are excluded from this act and shall not be part of
<u>Chapter 3 as to any building or horizontal addition with a two-</u>

1	hour separation from an existing building that exclusively
2	utilize noncombustible structural components or noncombustible
3	structural systems in a municipality if:
4	(1) The governing body of the municipality by resolution
5	adopts the exemption authorized by this subsection; or
6	(2) the electors of the municipality approve by
7	referendum the exemption authorized by this subsection.

9	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
