- Amending Title 26 (Eminent Domain) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for limited
- reimbursement of appraisal, attorney and engineering fees.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 710(a) of Title 26 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 710. Limited reimbursement of appraisal, attorney and
- 9 engineering fees.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- The owner of any right, title or interest
- 11 in real property acquired or injured by an acquiring agency, who
- 12 is not eligible for reimbursement of fees under section 306(q)
- 13 (relating to preliminary objections), 308(d) (relating to
- 14 revocation of condemnation proceedings) or 709 (relating to
- 15 condemnee's costs where no declaration of taking filed), shall
- 16 be reimbursed in an amount not to exceed \$4,000 per property,
- 17 REGARDLESS OF RIGHT, TITLE OR INTEREST, as a payment toward
- 18 reasonable expenses actually incurred for appraisal, attorney

- 1 and engineering fees, except where the taking is for an easement_
- 2 related to underground piping for water or sewer infrastructure,
- 3 <u>in which case the reimbursement is limited to \$1,000, REGARDLESS <---</u>
- 4 OF RIGHT, TITLE OR INTEREST.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
