9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. Section 18 of the act of May 31, 1945 (P.L.1198,
11	No.418), known as the Surface Mining Conservation and
12	Reclamation Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
13	Section 18. Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation
14	Fund; Remining Environmental Enhancement Fund; Remining
15	Financial Assurance Fund; Department Authority for Awarding of
16	Grants* * *
17	(g.1) There is hereby created an Aggregate Advisory Board to
18	assist the secretary to expend the funds for the purposes
19	provided by this act SECTION 17 OF THE ACT OF DECEMBER 19, 1984 <-
20	(P.L.1093, NO.219), KNOWN AS THE "NONCOAL SURFACE MINING

1	CONSERVATION AND RECLAMATION ACT," and to advise the secretary
2	on all matters pertaining to SURFACE mining, AS DEFINED IN <
3	SECTION 3 OF THE "NONCOAL SURFACE MINING CONSERVATION AND
4	RECLAMATION ACT," which shall include, but not be limited to
5	experimental practices, alternate methods of backfilling,
6	obligations for preexisting pollution liability, alteration of
7	reclamation plans, reclamation fees and bonding rates and
8	methods. The board shall function as follows:
9	(1) The board shall be comprised of THE SECRETARY; three <
10	(3) aggregate SURFACE mining operators; four (4) public <
11	members from the Citizens Advisory Council, who shall be
12	appointed by the council; one (1) member from the County
13	Conservation Districts, who shall be appointed by the State
14	Conservation District Commission; four (4) members of the <
15	<u>General Assembly, two (2) from the Senate, one (1) member</u>
16	from the majority party and one (1) member from the minority
17	party, who shall be appointed by the President pro tempore,
18	and two (2) from the House of Representatives, one (1) from
19	the majority party and one (1) from the minority party, who
20	shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
21	<u>Representatives.</u>
22	(2) The secretary shall chair the Aggregate Advisory
23	Board and appoint the members from the aggregate industry.
24	(3) All members shall be appointed for a term of two (2)
25	years, except that one-half of the initial members shall_
26	serve for three (3) years.
27	(4) All actions of the board shall be by majority vote.
28	The board shall meet upon the call of the secretary, but not
29	less than quarterly, to carry out its duties under this act.
30	The board shall select from among its members a chairperson

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1	and such other officers as it deems appropriate.	
2	(5) The board shall prepare and AN annual report on its	_ <
3	activities and submit the report to the Senate Environmental	-
4	Resources and Energy Committee and the House Conservation	<
5	ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY Committee.	<
