AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of SR 0056 over the Norfolk
2 Southern Railroad and Tenth Street, Seward Borough,
3 Westmoreland County, as the Clement J. Rolling Memorial
4 Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Clement J. Rolling Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--

9 (1) Clement J. "Clem" Rolling was a life-long resident
10 of Seward, Westmoreland County.

11 (2) During his military career with the Army Air
12 Reconnaissance Unit, Clem Rolling proudly served his country
13 for nearly five years in the Pacific Campaign in World War
14 II.

15 (3) Clem Rolling was honored by the Seward Volunteer
16 Fire Department in May 2013 for 50 years of volunteer
17 service.

18 (4) At the time of his death in May 2013, at the age of
19 94, Clem Rolling was the oldest living veteran in Seward and

1 had received several awards from his community for his
2 military service.

3 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on SR 0056 in Seward
4 Borough, Westmoreland County, over the Norfolk Southern Railroad
5 and Tenth Street is hereby designated the Clement J. Rolling
6 Memorial Bridge.

7 (c) Signs.---The Department of Transportation shall erect
8 and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge
9 to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

10 Section 2. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
