- 25 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the
- 26 <u>Combat Infantry Badge, accompanied by a fee of \$10 \$20 which</u>
- 27 <u>shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such</u>
- 28 documentation as the department shall require, the department
- 29 <u>shall issue to the person a special registration plate</u>
- 30 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who

- 1 <u>is a recipient of the Combat Infantry Badge. The special</u>
- 2 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
- 3 with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

- 8 (D) PENNSYLVANIA HUNTING HERITAGE FUND. -- FIFTEEN DOLLARS OF
- 9 <u>EACH FEE RECEIVED UNDER SECTION 1355.1 (RELATING TO PENNSYLVANIA</u>
- 10 HUNTING HERITAGE PLATE) SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE PENNSYLVANIA
- 11 HUNTING HERITAGE FUND, ESTABLISHED AS FOLLOWS:
- 12 <u>(1) THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED A SPECIAL ACCOUNT IN THE</u>
- 13 STATE TREASURY WHICH SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE PENNSYLVANIA
- 14 <u>HUNTING HERITAGE FUND. THE PURPOSE OF THE PENNSYLVANIA</u>
- 15 HUNTING HERITAGE FUND IS TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO NONPROFIT
- ORGANIZATIONS AS DEFINED UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE
- 17 INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 (PUBLIC LAW 99-514, 26 U.S.C. §
- 18 501(C)(3)) THAT COORDINATE THE PROCESSING AND DISTRIBUTION OF
- 19 DONATED WILD GAME FROM HUNTERS AND MUNICIPAL HERD REDUCTION
- 20 SOURCES TO PENNSYLVANIA RESIDENTS THROUGH A DISTRIBUTION
- 21 NETWORK OF FOOD BANKS IN THIS COMMONWEALTH, PROVIDED THAT 50%
- 22 OF THE MONEY IN THE SPECIAL ACCOUNT SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO
- NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS ESTABLISHED, PRIOR TO JANUARY 1,
- 24 2014, TO CONSERVE ALL BIRDS AND MAMMALS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH

- 28 COMMISSION AND MAY BE EXPENDED FOR THE PURPOSES AUTHORIZED
- 29 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- 30 (3) ESTIMATES OF AMOUNTS TO BE EXPENDED UNDER THIS

3	(4) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL NOT HONOR ANY REQUISITION
4	FOR EXPENDITURES BY THE PENNSYLVANIA GAME COMMISSION IN
5	EXCESS OF ESTIMATES APPROVED BY THE GOVERNOR OR IN EXCESS OF
6	THE AMOUNT AVAILABLE FOR THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE
7	REQUISITION WAS MADE, WHICHEVER IS THE LESSER AMOUNT.
