AN ACT

- 1 Relating to the satisfaction SURRENDER of oil and gas leases; <-2 and providing for certain forms and damages.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Oil and Gas
- 7 Lease Satisfaction SURRENDER Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Lessee." A person who has obtained the right to explore,
- 13 drill, stimulate, produce, market and sell the oil, gas and
- 14 natural gas liquids, or portion of the oil, gas and natural gas
- 15 liquids, by means of a properly executed lease.
- 16 "Lessor." An owner of the oil and gas in place who controls
- 17 the oil and gas rights and has executed a lease.

- 1 Section 3. Satisfaction SURRENDERING, methods and indexing.
- 2 (a) Methods of satisfying SURRENDERING oil and gas leases. -- <--

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- 3 (1) Oil and gas leases shall be satisfied SURRENDERED by <--
- 4 satisfaction SURRENDER documents as described in sections 5 <--
- 5 and 6 by the recording officer of the applicable county. A
- 6 satisfaction SURRENDER document shall be accompanied by
- 7 information sufficient to validate the original oil and gas
- 8 lease recording information in the public record, which shall
- 9 include the following:
- 10 (i) The A COPY OF THE RECORDED MEMORANDUM OR LEASE <--
- OR, IF NOT AVAILABLE, THE original oil and gas lease.
- 12 (ii) A records fee established by the recording
- officer.
- 14 (2) A recording officer shall give notice of the
- 15 recording validation procedure. The notice shall be entitled
- "Notice by (recording officer) to Adopt Recording Information
- 17 Validation Procedure under the Oil and Gas Lease Satisfaction <--
- 18 SURRENDER Act," and shall state any additional fees to be
- charged and shall be advertised in the county recorder's
- yearly fee schedule or fee bill, whichever is applicable.
- 21 (b) Indexing. -- The recording officer shall properly index
- 22 all satisfaction SURRENDER documents against the name of the <--
- 23 lessee or last assignee as each is indicated in the satisfaction <--
- 24 SURRENDER document and shall indicate the recording of each
- 25 satisfaction SURRENDER document in the oil and gas lease record. <--
- 26 (c) Liability of recording officer. -- Nothing in this act
- 27 shall impose liability on any recording officer or any political
- 28 subdivision for a mistake, error or inaccuracy found in a
- 29 satisfaction SURRENDER document which was presented for
- 30 recording by a person or entity and which was recorded by the

- 1 recording officer or political subdivision.
- 2 Section 4. Requirement and effect of satisfaction SURRENDER

- 3 document.
- 4 Every lessee shall, within 30 days after expiration,
- 5 termination or forfeiture of the oil and gas lease, present for
- 6 recording in the office where the oil and gas lease is recorded
- 7 a duly executed satisfaction SURRENDER document in substantially <--
- 8 the form set out in section 5 and acknowledged as provided by
- 9 law. The satisfaction SURRENDER document shall thereafter <--
- 10 discharge, defeat and release a lessee's interests in the lease
- 11 upon recording.
- 12 Section 5. Form of satisfaction SURRENDER document.
- 13 A lessee, whether an individual or legal entity, shall
- 14 satisfy SURRENDER oil and gas leases by a satisfaction SURRENDER <--
- 15 document in substantially the following form:

11	Section 6. Notice to satisfy SURRENDER and damages for failure	<
12	to satisfy SURRENDER.	<
13	(a) NoticeAfter the time set forth in section 4, the	
14	lessor may send a notice to the lessee to present for recording	
15	a satisfaction SURRENDER document to avoid damages.	<
16	(b) DeliveryThe satisfaction notice to satisfy SURRENDER	<
17	shall be sent to the lessee by certified or registered mail,	
18	return receipt requested. The satisfaction notice shall be sent	<
19	to the lessee at the lessee's address designated in the oil and	
20	gas lease unless the person issuing the notice has actually	
21	received from the lessee another name or address to which	
22	requests for satisfactions are A NOTICE IS to be sent.	<
23	(c) FormThe notice to satisfy SURRENDER shall be in	<
24	substantially the following form:

25	(d) Penalty for failure to satisfy SURRENDER	<
26	(1) If, within 60 days of the lessee's receipt of the	
27	first written request by the lessor for the satisfaction	<
28	SURRENDER document, delivered and in substantially the form	<
29	described in this section, the lessee fails to present for	
30	recording to the office where the oil and gas lease was	

- 1 recorded a satisfaction SURRENDER document as described in
- 2 section 5 or the oil and gas lease is not otherwise satisfied <--

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- 3 SURRENDERED, the lessee LESSOR may initiate an appropriate <--
- 4 court action to compel satisfaction SURRENDER of the lease, <--
- 5 unless a satisfactory reason was provided BY THE LESSEE as to <--
- 6 why the oil and gas lease shall SHOULD not be satisfied <--
- 7 SURRENDERED. <--
- 8 (2) In a successful action to compel satisfaction <-9 SURRENDER of the lease, the lessee shall reimburse the lessor <-10 for costs of the action, including the lessor's reasonable
- 12 (3) An action under this section shall be the exclusive
 13 remedy for damages for failure of a lessee to issue and
 14 present for recording a satisfaction SURRENDER document.
- 15 (4) The delivery of a second or subsequent written

 16 request by the lessor for a satisfaction SURRENDER document <-
 17 shall not give rise to an additional cause of action under

 18 this section.
- 19 Section 7. Other rules or laws not affected.
- This act shall not affect nor impair any other act or any
- 21 rule of civil procedure promulgated by the Pennsylvania Supreme
- 22 Court, which provides for the satisfaction SURRENDER or
- 23 discharge of an oil and gas lease by order or decree of any
- 24 court upon payment of an applicable fee. The recording officer
- 25 shall accept for recording a copy of the order or decree
- 26 certified by the prothonotary and shall index and indicate the
- 27 same in the record as is provided in this act for a satisfaction <--
- 28 SURRENDER document. Except as provided in section 3(a), this act <--
- 29 shall not affect or impair any other act providing for fees for
- 30 the recording of the documents and instruments provided for in

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attorney fees.

- 2 Section 8. Prior instruments.
- 3 Written satisfaction SURRENDER or intended satisfaction <
 - <--
- 4 SURRENDER given prior to the EFFECTIVE date of this act SECTION <--
- 5 with respect to any oil and gas lease on real property situate
- 6 in this Commonwealth shall be deemed good, valid and effective
- 7 in law for the purposes therein recited.
- 8 Section 9. Applicability.
- 9 This UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED BY CONTRACT, THIS act shall <--
- 10 apply to every oil and gas lease on real property in this
- 11 Commonwealth which has not been satisfied SURRENDERED prior to <--
- 12 the effective date of this section and regardless of whether the
- 13 oil and gas lease was executed before the effective date of this
- 14 section.
- 15 Section 10. Effective date.
- 16 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
