AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against public decency,
- providing for the offense of Internet posting of criminal
- 4 activity; and imposing a penalty.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5905. Internet posting of criminal activity.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits an offense under this
- 11 <u>section if the person posts on a publicly accessible Internet</u>
- 12 website any photograph, film, videotape or similar recording of
- 13 the identifiable image of any person engaged in activity that
- 14 would constitute a "personal injury crime" as defined in section
- 15 <u>103 of the act of November 24, 1998 (P.L.882, No.111), known as</u>
- 16 the Crime Victims Act.
- 17 (b) Applicability. -- It shall not be an offense under this
- 18 section for any of the following to post information prohibited
- 19 under this section:

- 1 (1) A law enforcement agency.
- 2 (2) A bona fide news organization.
- 3 (c) Grading. -- An offense under this section is:
- 4 (1) Except as set forth in paragraph (2), a misdemeanor
- 5 <u>of the second degree.</u>
- 6 (2) A misdemeanor of the first degree when the person
- 7 <u>depicted is an individual under 18 years of age or an</u>
- 8 <u>individual 65 years of age or older.</u>
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
