A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of April 6 through 12, 2014, as the "Week  
2 of the Young Child" in Pennsylvania.

5 Young Children, are celebrating the Week of the Young Child from  
6 April 6 through 12, 2014; and

11 development and to building better futures for all children; and

12 WHEREAS, Working families need child care and supportive
