## AN ACT

9	Section 1. Section 16 of the act of March 2, 1956 (1955
10	P.L.1211, No.376), known as the Practical Nurse Law, is amended
11	by adding a subsection to read:
12	Section 16. Refusal, Suspension or Revocation of License;
13	Grounds* * *
14	(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, if the
15	<u>licensee is convicted of an offense under section 13(a)(12) of</u>
16	the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as "The
17	Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act," or a
18	substantially similar offense in another state, the board shall_
19	permanently revoke the license of the licensee.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
