## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), 1 entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the licensing of 2 eligible organizations to conduct games of chance, for the 3 licensing of persons to distribute games of chance, for the registration of manufacturers of games of chance, and for 5 suspensions and revocations of licenses and permits; requiring records; providing for local referendum by 7 electorate; and prescribing penalties," in preliminary 8 provisions, further providing for the definition of "games of chance"; and defining "coin auction." 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The definition of "games of chance" in section 13 14 103 of the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, amended November 24, 15 2013 (P.L.1045, No.90) and November 27, 2013 (P.L.1062, No.92), 16 17 is amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to 18 read: 19 Section 103. Definitions. 20 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 3 "Coin auction." A game in which a participant buys a
- 4 <u>numbered paddle for a chance to bid on a donated prize with the</u>
- 5 winner determined by a random drawing of corresponding numbers.

- 7 "Games of chance." Punchboards, daily drawings, weekly
- 8 drawings, 50/50 drawings, raffles, coin auctions, tavern games,
- 9 pools, race night games and pull-tabs, as defined in this act,
- 10 provided that no such game shall be played by or with the
- 11 assistance of any mechanical or electrical devices or media
- 12 other than a dispensing machine or passive selection device and
- 13 further provided that the particular chance taken by any person
- 14 in any such game shall not be made contingent upon any other
- 15 occurrence or the winning of any other contest, but shall be
- 16 determined solely at the discretion of the purchaser. This
- 17 definition shall not be construed to authorize any other form of
- 18 gambling currently prohibited under any provision of 18 Pa.C.S.
- 19 (relating to crimes and offenses) or authorized under 4 Pa.C.S.
- 20 (relating to amusements). Nothing in this act shall be construed
- 21 to authorize games commonly known as "slot machines" or "video
- 22 poker" or other games regulated by the Pennsylvania Gaming
- 23 Control Board.

- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
