6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 3503(d) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes, amended November 6, 2014 (P.L.2921,
9	No.192), is amended and the section is amended by adding a
10	subsection to read:
11	§ 3503. Criminal trespass.

13	(b.4) Evaluation for gambling disorder
14	(1) Upon conviction, adjudication or plea of nolo
15	contendere, including admission to Accelerated Rehabilitative
16	Disposition or other pretrial diversion program of a person
17	for an offense committed under subsection (b) or (b.1), where
18	the person's name is included on a self-exclusion list and
19	the offense was committed at a licensed facility, the court

1	may direct that the person be evaluated in a manner deemed
2	appropriate by the court to determine if:
3	(i) if the person has a gambling disorder; and
4	(ii) whether there is a need for counseling or
5	treatment as part of the sentence or preadjudication
6	disposition.
7	(2) The evaluation shall be conducted by a single county
8	authority for drug and alcohol or its designee and shall
9	include recommendations for levels of care, continuing care
10	and monitoring.

12	(d) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
13	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
14	subsection:
15	"Evaluation." An assessment performed by a clinician who
16	meets the minimum qualifications prescribed by the Department of
17	Drug and Alcohol Programs for the provision of gambling disorder
18	<u>counseling.</u>
19	"Licensed gaming entity." As defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 1103
20	(relating to definitions).
21	"Licensed facility." As defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 1103.
22	"School grounds." Any building of or grounds of any
23	elementary or secondary publicly funded educational institution,
24	any elementary or secondary private school licensed by the
25	Department of Education, any elementary or secondary parochial
26	school, any certified day-care center or any licensed preschool
27	program.
28	"Secondary metal." As defined in section 3935 (relating to
29	theft of secondary metal).
30	"Self-exclusion list." The list established and maintained

- 2 (relating to list of persons self excluded from gaming
- 3 <u>activities</u>) or a self-exclusion list maintained by a licensed
- 4 gaming entity which meets the minimum criteria stated in 4
- 5 <u>Pa.C.S. § 1516.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
