AN ACT

Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in revenues relating to gaming, further providing 2 for establishment of State Gaming Fund and net slot machine 3 revenue distribution. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1403(c)(2)(iii)(A) of Title 4 of the 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 1403. Establishment of State Gaming Fund and net slot machine 10 revenue distribution. 11 12 (c) Transfers and distributions. -- The department shall: * * * 13 (2) From the local share assessment established in 14 15 subsection (b), make quarterly distributions among the 16 counties hosting a licensed facility in accordance with the 17 following schedule:

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1	(iii) If the facility is a Category 2 licensed
2	facility and if the county in which the licensed facility
3	is located is:

(A) A county of the first class: 4% of the gross terminal revenue to the county hosting the licensed facility from each such licensed facility. Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, funds from licensed gaming entities located within a county of the first class shall not be distributed outside of a county of the first class. The [first \$5,000,000 of the] total amount distributed annually to the county of the first class <u>under this part</u> shall be distributed to the Philadelphia School District.

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16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
