AN ACT Amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for industrial hemp research; imposing 2 powers and duties on the Department of Agriculture and the 3 Legislative Reference Bureau; abrogating a regulation; and 4 5 making a related repeal. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 8 Section 1. Title 3 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes 9 is amended by adding a chapter to read: 10 CHAPTER 7 11 INDUSTRIAL HEMP RESEARCH 12 Sec. 13 701. Scope. 14 702. Definitions. 15 703. - 2 § 701. Scope.
- 3 This chapter relates to industrial hemp research.
- 4 § 702. Definitions.
- 5 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 6 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 7 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 8 <u>"Agricultural pilot program." A pilot program to study the</u>
- 9 growth, cultivation or marketing of industrial hemp.
- 10 "Department." The Department of Agriculture of the
- 11 Commonwealth.
- 12 "Industrial hemp." The plant Cannabis sativa L. and any part
- 13 of the plant, whether growing or not, with a delta-9
- 14 <u>tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of not more than 0.3% on a</u>
- 15 <u>dry-weight basis.</u>
- 16 "Institution of higher education." As defined by section 101
- 17 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (Public Law 89-329, 20
- 18 <u>U.S.C.</u> § 1001).
- 19 "Secretary." The Secretary of Agriculture of the
- 20 Commonwealth.
- 21 § 703. Administration.
- 22 (a) Department. -- The department has the following duties:
- 23 <u>(1) Implement this chapter.</u>
- 24 (2) Establish a certification and registration program
- 25 under section 704(b)(2) (relating to growth and cultivation)
- and, when the program is operative, transmit notice of that
- 27 <u>fact to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in</u>
- the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 29 (b) Regulations.--The department may promulgate regulations
- 30 to implement this chapter.

- 1 (c) Secretary.--If the secretary determines that a Federal
- 2 agency is authorized to regulate industrial hemp, the secretary
- 3 shall transmit notice of that authorization to the bureau for
- 4 <u>publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.</u>
- 5 § 704. Growth and cultivation.
- 6 (a) Authorization. -- Notwithstanding section 4(1)(vii)1 of
- 7 the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The
- 8 Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, industrial
- 9 hemp may be grown or cultivated by the department or an
- 10 institution of higher education for the purposes of research
- 11 conducted under an agricultural pilot program in compliance with
- 12 subsection (b).
- (b) Manner. -- Industrial hemp shall be grown or cultivated in
- 14 a manner that complies with all of the following:
- 15 <u>(1) Ensures that only institutions of higher education</u>
- and the department are used to grow or cultivate industrial
- hemp.
- 18 (2) Requires that sites used for growing or cultivating
- industrial hemp be certified by and registered with the
- department.
- 21 § 705. Abrogation of regulation.
- The provisions of 7 Pa. Code § 110.1(1) (relating to noxious
- 23 <u>weed control list) are abrogated.</u>
- 24 § 706. Expiration.
- 25 This chapter shall expire upon publication of the notice
- 26 under section 703(c) (relating to administration).
- 27 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:
- 28 (1) The General Assembly finds and declares that the
- repeal under paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the
- 30 addition of 3 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7.

- 1 (2) Section 8(1) of the act of April 7, 1982 (P.L.228,
- No.74), known as the Noxious Weed Control Law, is repealed.
- 3 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 4 (1) The following provisions shall take effect
- 5 immediately:
- 6 (i) The addition of 3 Pa.C.S. § 703.
- 7 (ii) Section 2(1) of this act.
- 8 (iii) This section.
- 9 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect upon
- publication of the notice under 3 Pa.C.S. § 703(a)(2).
