General and specific powers. 11 12 (a) General powers. --13 (7) The board shall not promulgate rules and regulations 14 15 allowing any form of Internet gambling. * * * 16 17 Section 2. Section 5513(e) of Title 18 is amended and the 18 section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 19 § 5513. Gambling devices, gambling, etc. 20 * * *

- 1 (d.1) Internet gambling. -- No individual or entity shall_
- 2 solicit, invite, collect or accept cash or any other form of
- 3 currency through the Internet for the purposes of wagering or
- 4 betting. No individual or entity shall organize, or cause to be
- 5 organized, any type of gambling event that is held over the
- 6 <u>Internet.</u>
- 7 (e) Penalty.--
- 8 <u>(1)</u> Any person who fails to provide records as provided
- 9 in subsection (d) commits a summary offense.
- 10 (2) A first offense under subsection (d.1) shall be
- 11 <u>considered a first offense punishable by a fine of not more</u>
- 12 than \$300.
- 13 (3) A second offense under subsection (d.1) shall be
- considered a summary offense punishable by a fine of not more
- than \$600 and a term of imprisonment not to exceed three
- 16 days.
- 17 (4) A third or subsequent offense under subsection (d.1)
- 18 shall be considered a third degree misdemeanor.

- 20 Section 3. The following provisions shall apply to bets and
- 21 wagers placed on or after the effective date of this section:
- 22 (1) The addition of 4 Pa.C.S. § 1202(a)(7).

- 25 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
