Pedestrians soliciting rides or business. 9 No person shall: 10 Stand on a roadway for the purpose of soliciting a 11 ride. 12 Stand on a roadway for the purpose of soliciting employment, business or contributions from the occupant of 1.3 14 any vehicle. This paragraph does not apply to a charitable 15 organization registered under the act of December 19, 1990
