## AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of State Route 2026, also known as Blair  
2 Mill Road, in Montgomery County as the Private First Class  
3 Paul T. Wright Memorial Highway.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Private First Class Paul T. Wright Memorial Highway.

7 (a) Findings.--

8 (1) Private First Class Paul T. Wright was a resident of  
9 Willow Grove, Pennsylvania, before enlisting in the United  
10 States Army.

11 (2) PFC Wright was assigned to the 3rd Platoon, C  
12 Company, 26th Engineer Battalion, Americal Division of the  
13 United States Army in Vietnam.

14 (3) While valiantly serving his country, PFC Wright, at

20 years of age, was killed by an explosive device on April 3, 1968, in the Quang Ngai Province of South Vietnam.

(b) Designation.--The section of State Route 2026, also known as Blair Mill Road, in Montgomery County from Easton Road to Horsham Road is hereby designated the Private First Class Paul T. Wright Memorial Highway.

(c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to traffic in both directions on the highway.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect ~~immediately~~ IN 60 DAYS.
