AN ACT

Designating a portion of state Route 2026, also known as Blair Mill Road, in Montgomery County as the Private First Class Paul T. Wright Memorial Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Private First Class Paul T. Wright Memorial Highway.
(a) Findings.--
(1) Private First Class Paul T. Wright was a resident of Willow Grove, Pennsylvania, before enlisting in the United States Army.
(2) PFC Wright was assigned to the 3rd Platoon, C Company, 26 th Engineer Battalion, Americal Division of the United States Army in Vietnam.
(3) While valiantly serving his country, PFC Wright, at 6 Paul T. Wright Memorial Highway. 8 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
