A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, prohibiting payroll collection of dues, fees and political contributions.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	(1) That Article VI heading be amended to read:
9	ARTICLE VI
10	PUBLIC OFFICERS AND PUBLIC EMPLOYEES
11	(2) That Article VI be amended by adding a section to read:
12	§ 8. Payroll collection of dues, fees and political
13	contributions.
14	No Commonwealth officer or agency, or independent agency or
15	public authority created by the Commonwealth, nor the General
16	Assembly, or officer or agency of the General Assembly, nor a
17	court, or officer or agency, of the unified judicial system, nor

a political subdivision of the Commonwealth, or authority
created by such political subdivision, may use its payroll
system to collect membership dues, nonmembership fees or a
political contribution from an employee. A provision in a
collective bargaining agreement which authorizes collection in
violation of this section is void.

Upon the first passage by the General 7 Section 2. (a) Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the 8 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 9 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 10 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 11 12 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 13 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 14 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

15 Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this (b) 16 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 17 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 18 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 19 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 20 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 21 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 22 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 23 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 24 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 25 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 26 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 27 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 28 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 29 passed by the General Assembly.

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
