AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in decorations, medals, badges and awards, further providing for authorized decorations, medals, badges and awards.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3701 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 3701. Authorized decorations, medals, badges and awards.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- The following decorations, medals, badges
- 11 and awards are authorized to be presented by the Governor in the
- 12 name of the Commonwealth:
- 13 (1) Pennsylvania Cross for Valor.
- 14 (2) Pennsylvania Distinguished Service Medal.
- 15 (3) Pennsylvania Meritorious Service Medal.
- 16 (4) Pennsylvania Commendation Medal.

- 1 (4.1) Pennsylvania Achievement Medal.
- 2 (5) State Medal for Federal Service during any war.
- 3 (6) Pennsylvania Service Ribbon or Medal for active 4 State service during an emergency.
- 5 (7) Pennsylvania Twenty Year Service Medal.
- 6 (8) Major General Thomas R. White, Jr. Medal.
- 7 (9) General Thomas J. Stewart Medal.
- 8 (10) Pennsylvania Outstanding Aeronautical Achievement
- 9 Award.
- 10 (11) Marksmanship Medals or Badges.
- 11 (12) Pennsylvania Veterans Service Award.
- 12 (b) Method of award. -- The following decorations, medals,
- 13 badges and awards will be awarded under the following
- 14 conditions:
- 15 (1) The Pennsylvania Cross for Valor shall be awarded by
- the Governor to members of the Pennsylvania National Guard,
- 17 Pennsylvania Guard or the armed forces of the United States
- 18 or their reserve components for acts of bravery or valor
- above the ordinary gallantry of other members of the
- 20 services.
- 21 (2) The Pennsylvania Distinguished Service Medal shall
- be awarded by the Governor to <u>civilians</u>, <u>veterans</u> and members
- of the Pennsylvania National Guard, Pennsylvania Guard or
- 24 armed forces of the United States or their reserve components
- in recognition of meritorious service beyond the normal
- 26 dictates of duty to this Commonwealth.
- 27 (3) The Pennsylvania Meritorious Service Medal shall be
- awarded by the Governor to civilians, veterans and members of
- 29 the Pennsylvania National Guard, Pennsylvania Guard or the
- 30 armed forces of the United States or their reserve components

- 1 in recognition of meritorious service rendered this
- 2 Commonwealth and while holding a position of great
- 3 responsibility or who provide meritorious service to veterans
- 4 <u>and their families on behalf of this Commonwealth</u>.
- 5 (4) The qualifications for awarding the Pennsylvania
- 6 Commendation Medal, the Pennsylvania Achievement Medal, the
- 7 <u>Pennsylvania Veterans Service Award</u>, the State Medal for
- 8 Federal Service during any war, the Service Ribbon or Medal
- 9 for active State service during an emergency, the
- 10 Pennsylvania Twenty Year Service Medal, the Major General
- 11 Thomas R. White, Jr. Medal, the General Thomas J. Stewart
- 12 Medal, the Pennsylvania Outstanding Aeronautical Achievement
- Award, and the Marksmanship Medals or Badges, shall be
- 14 prescribed by the Adjutant General by regulation.
- 15 (5) The Adjutant General is empowered to establish such
- other decorations, medals, badges and awards as he may
- 17 prescribe by regulation.
- 18 (c) Recommendations for medals.--All recommendations for
- 19 decorations, medals, badges and awards, except those of the
- 20 Governor, must be forwarded to the Governor through the
- 21 department.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
