AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for 2 person with disability plate and placard. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 5 Section 1. Section 1338(c)(1) and (2) of Title 75 of the 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 8 § 1338. Person with disability plate and placard. * * * 9 10 (c) Health care provider's statement.--11 Any person applying for a special plate or parking 12 placard for persons with disabilities must present a 13 statement, certified by a physician, podiatrist, 14 chiropractor, optometrist, physician assistant or certified 15 registered nurse practitioner licensed or certified to

practice in this Commonwealth or in a contiquous state, that

the person with a disability is disabled as provided in

2 (2) Any person applying for a renewal of registration of 3 a special plate for persons with disabilities must comply with this subsection. Once a person with a disability has 5 been duly certified by a physician, podiatrist, chiropractor, 6 optometrist, physician assistant or certified registered nurse practitioner as being disabled, as provided in 7 8 subsection (a), the applicant need not submit a certification for subsequent renewals of registration for a special plate 9 10 for persons with disabilities. A person who was issued a person with disability plate under this section and no longer 11 qualifies for one shall not be charged a replacement fee for 13 a regular registration plate upon payment of the regular registration fee.
