AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of State Route 2005 in Drexel Hill,
2 Delaware County, as the Officer Dennis McNamara Memorial
3 Highway.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Officer Dennis McNamara Memorial Highway.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
8 follows:

9 (1) Officer Dennis McNamara was born July 4, 1958, and
10 graduated from West Catholic High School.

11 (2) Officer McNamara served in the United States Air
12 Force from February 1981 to February 1987 where he developed
13 a background in military intelligence and was a linguist in
14 several Middle Eastern languages.

15 (3) Officer McNamara joined the Upper Darby Police Force
16 in July 1993 where he served for eight years before giving

1 his life in the line of duty.

2 (4) On January 30, 2002, Officer McNamara was
3 investigating a suspicious vehicle and occupant in the
4 Cardington Section of Upper Darby before being fatally
5 wounded as he exited his vehicle.

6 (b) Designation.--The section of State Route 2005, known as
7 Lansdowne Avenue, Delaware County, from State Road to School
8 Lane is hereby designated the Officer Dennis McNamara Memorial
9 Highway.

10 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
11 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the road to
12 traffic in both directions on the road.

13 Section 2. Effective date.

14 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
