## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in operation of vehicles, providing for autonomous 2 and connected vehicles. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. The following words and phrases when used in this chapter

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 3 "Autonomous technology." Equipment, devices or other
- 4 technology installed on a motor vehicle, either by the original
- 5 equipment manufacturer or an aftermarket installer, which
- 6 renders the motor vehicle capable of driving or operating
- 7 without the active control of a human operator. The term does
- 8 <u>not include an active safety system or any system for driver</u>
- 9 <u>assistance</u>, including, but not limited to, a system to provide
- 10 electronic blind spot detection, crash avoidance, emergency
- 11 braking, parking assistance, adaptive cruise control, lane
- 12 <u>keeping assistance</u>, <u>lane departure warning or traffic jam and</u>
- 13 queuing assistance, unless the system, alone or in combination
- 14 with any other system, enables the vehicle to drive without the
- 15 <u>active control or monitoring of a human operator.</u>
- 16 <u>"Autonomous vehicle." A motor vehicle that is equipped with</u>
- 17 autonomous technology that can operate without the active
- 18 physical control or monitoring of a human operator. The term
- 19 includes vehicles that are engaged in platooning.
- 20 "Autonomous vehicle tester." A manufacturer, educational
- 21 institution, automotive equipment or technology provider, fleet
- 22 operator or other person that is certified by the Department of
- 23 Transportation to conduct testing and that has been authorized
- 24 by the department to conduct public testing of an autonomous
- 25 vehicle.
- 26 "Operation." The operation of an autonomous vehicle on a
- 27 <u>test road for the purpose of testing.</u>
- 28 "Operator." An individual employed by or affiliated with an
- 29 <u>autonomous vehicle tester who is able to take immediate physical</u>
- 30 or remote control of the autonomous vehicle.

- 1 "Platooning." Use of equipment, a device or technology that
- 2 allows a motor vehicle or series of motor vehicles to operate in
- 3 <u>an autonomous mode while coupled or joined to a lead vehicle via</u>
- 4 <u>a wireless connection in a caravan or motorcade.</u>
- 5 "Test road." Any of the following:
- 6 <u>(1) A trafficway.</u>
- 7 <u>(2)</u> A turnpike.
- 8 "Turnpike." As defined in 74 Pa.C.S. § 8102 (relating to
- 9 definitions).
- 10 <u>SUBCHAPTER B</u>

- 20 § 3610. Safety and control.
- 21 When an autonomous vehicle is being operated, the operator
- 22 must:
- 23 (1) Possess a valid class of license for the type of
- 24 <u>autonomous vehicle being operated.</u>
- 25 (2) Be able to take immediate physical or remote control
- of the autonomous vehicle in the event of a failure or
- 27 malfunction of the autonomous technology or other emergency.
- 28 (3) Be within 1,000 miles of the autonomous vehicle if
- 29 <u>controlling the autonomous vehicle remotely.</u>
- 30 (4) Continuously monitor the operation of the autonomous

- 1 vehicle.
- 2 (5) Ensure that an autonomous vehicle will not be
- 3 operated unless the autonomous vehicle is:
- 4 (i) Equipped with a means to engage and disengage
- 5 <u>the autonomous technology which is easily accessible to</u>
- 6 <u>the operator.</u>
- 7 (ii) Equipped with a means to alert the operator to
- 8 <u>take physical control of the autonomous vehicle if the</u>
- 9 <u>autonomous technology has failed and the failure affects</u>
- 10 <u>the ability of the autonomous technology to safely</u>
- 11 <u>operate the autonomous vehicle.</u>
- 12 <u>(iii) Marked in a manner approved by the department</u>
- as being under remote control operation if the autonomous
- vehicle is being controlled without a human operator in
- 15 the vehicle.
- 16 § 3611. Registration.
- 17 An autonomous vehicle may not be registered in this
- 18 Commonwealth unless it meets Federal and State laws. If the
- 19 autonomous technology or autonomous vehicle does not meet
- 20 Federal and State laws for the purpose of testing, the
- 21 <u>autonomous vehicle tester must obtain approval from the</u>
- 22 <u>department</u>.
- 23 § 3612. Operation.
- 24 (a) Contract. -- The department may enter into a contract with
- 25 an autonomous vehicle tester for the purpose of operating an
- 26 autonomous vehicle. If operation will occur on the turnpike, the
- 27 Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission must be made a party to the
- 28 contract.
- 29 (b) Prohibition.--An autonomous vehicle tester may not
- 30 conduct autonomous vehicle operation without a valid contract. A

- 1 person conducting autonomous vehicle operation, except as
- 2 provided under a contract entered into under subsection (a),
- 3 commits a misdemeanor of the third degree.
- 4 (c) Insurance or bond. -- An autonomous vehicle tester must do
- 5 the following before operating an autonomous vehicle on a test
- 6 road:
- 7 (1) Submit to the department proof of general liability
- 8 <u>insurance or self-insurance, acceptable to the department, in</u>
- 9 the amount of \$5,000,000.
- 10 (2) Provide proof of financial responsibility for the
- 11 <u>vehicle as provided under Chapter 17 (relating to financial</u>
- 12 <u>responsibility</u>).
- 13 <u>§ 3613. Policy.</u>
- 14 (a) Adoption. -- The department may adopt a policy authorizing
- 15 the operation of autonomous vehicles as provided for under a
- 16 contract entered into under section 3612(a) (relating to
- 17 operation). The policy may:
- 18 <u>(1) Establish requirements that an autonomous vehicle</u>
- 19 tester must meet before operation of an autonomous vehicle.
- 20 (2) Establish requirements that an autonomous vehicle
- 21 must meet before operation, including minimum safety
- 22 <u>standards for autonomous vehicles and their operation and the</u>
- 23 minimum number of hours an autonomous vehicle must meet on a
- 24 <u>test road with low average daily traffic as determined by the</u>
- 25 department before the autonomous vehicle is introduced on a
- 26 <u>test road with high average daily traffic as determined by</u>
- the department.
- 28 (3) Establish requirements for an operator.
- 29 <u>(4) Restrict the operation of autonomous vehicles to</u>
- 30 specified geographic areas, classes and types of testing

- 1 roads and time and weather conditions.
- 2 (5) Provide for other requirements as the department
- determines to be necessary in consultation with the
- 4 <u>chairperson and minority chairperson of the Transportation</u>
- 5 <u>Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and minority</u>
- 6 <u>chairperson of the Transportation Committee of the House of</u>
- 7 <u>Representatives.</u>
- 8 (b) Publication. -- The department shall submit for
- 9 <u>publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin any policy adopted</u>
- 10 under subsection (a) and place the policy on the department's
- 11 <u>publicly accessible Internet website.</u>
- 12 <u>§ 3614. Operator.</u>
- 13 The operator shall be deemed to be the driver or operator of
- 14 <u>an autonomous vehicle under this title.</u>
- 15 § 3615. Disciplinary action.
- 16 The department may suspend or cancel a contract to operate
- 17 autonomous vehicles for any grounds determined by the
- 18 <u>department</u>.
- 19 § 3616. Reporting.
- 20 (a) Autonomous vehicle tester. -- An autonomous vehicle tester
- 21 <u>must provide the following reports to the department:</u>
- 22 (1) Notwithstanding any other obligation to report an
- 23 <u>accident under this title, an accident involving an</u>
- 24 <u>autonomous vehicle that is being operated on a test road</u>
- 25 <u>under the authority of this chapter. The report must:</u>
- 26 (i) Be made within 10 days of the occurrence.
- 27 <u>(ii) Be made on a form supplied by the department.</u>
- 28 <u>(iii) Include whether the accident resulted in</u>
- 29 towing of the autonomous vehicle or other involved
- 30 vehicle or whether an injury resulted from the accident

- 2 <u>enforcement agency and law enforcement incident number.</u>
- 3 (2) Any instance, on a biannual basis, where the
- 4 <u>operator was required to disengage the vehicle from</u>
- 5 <u>autonomous mode as a result of a failure of the autonomous</u>
- 6 <u>technology</u>, AS <u>DETERMINED</u> BY THE <u>DEPARTMENT</u>.
- 7 (3) The status of autonomous vehicle testing.
- 8 (b) Department. -- Annually, the department, in coordination
- 9 with the Pennsylvania State Police, shall submit a report to the

- 10 chairperson and minority chairperson of the Transportation
- 11 Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and minority
- 12 <u>chairperson of the Transportation Committee of the House of</u>
- 13 Representatives that describes the status of autonomous vehicle
- 14 testing, including, but not limited to, autonomous vehicle
- 15 testers, number and type of accidents and recommendations to
- 16 <u>improve autonomous vehicle testing.</u>
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
