## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in size, weight and load, further providing for 2 maximum gross weight of vehicles. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 4941 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 4941. Maximum gross weight of vehicles. \* \* \* 9 10 (d) Natural gas vehicles .--(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a 11 12 vehicle that is operated by an engine fueled primarily by 13 compressed or liquefied natural gas may exceed the gross 14 vehicle weight limits and any axle weight limits imposed 15 under this subchapter by an amount, not to exceed a maximum 16 of 2,000 pounds, that is equal to the difference between the

weight of the vehicle attributable to the natural gas tank

- 1 and fueling system carried by the vehicle and the weight of a
- 2 <u>comparable diesel tank and fueling system.</u>
- 3 (2) The weight exemption provided for under this
- 4 <u>subsection shall apply to all State highways and interstate</u>
- 5 <u>highways as provided by the exemption permitted under 23</u>
- 6 <u>U.S.C.</u> § 127 (relating to vehicle weight limitations -
- 7 <u>Interstate System</u>).
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
