## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for certain nonnatural earthquake insurance coverage;
- conferring powers and imposing duties on the Insurance
- 3 Department; and providing for enforcement and penalties.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Nonnatural
- 8 Earthquake Insurance Coverage Act.
- 9 Section 2. Legislative intent.
- 10 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 11 (1) The increased drilling activity for natural gas in
- 12 this Commonwealth has provided an economic benefit to the
- 13 Commonwealth.
- 14 (2) Seismic testing is a process whereby an image of the
- subsurface is created and the data obtained is then used by
- 16 an oil and gas company to locate the best place to drill.
- 17 (3) Seismic testing uses blasts of sound that can cause
- 18 earthquake-like effects.

- 1 (4) These seismic tests can result in damage to a
- 2 structure's foundation or cause other damage to property.
- 3 (5) Often times a homeowner purchases an earthquake
- 4 endorsement for an insurance policy with the understanding
- 5 that the homeowner's property will be covered in the event
- 6 that the property is damaged by all earth movement events,
- 7 but the homeowner then discovers that the policy does not
- 8 cover nonnatural or human activity that causes earth
- 9 movement.
- 10 Section 3. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Claim." A formal request to an insurance company asking for
- 15 a payment based on the terms of the insurance policy.
- 16 "Department." The Insurance Department of the Commonwealth.
- 17 "Earthquake." A shaking of a part of the earth's surface
- 18 that often causes damage.
- 19 "Endorsement." A written provision that adds to, deletes or
- 20 modifies the provisions of the insurance contract to which the
- 21 provision is attached.
- 22 Section 4. Nonnatural earthquake insurance coverage.
- No insurance policy, or any endorsement thereto, covering
- 24 owner-occupied private residential property located in this
- 25 Commonwealth shall, for the purpose of payment of a claim or any
- 26 other benefit in the policy or endorsement, distinguish between
- 27 earthquakes occurring naturally and earthquakes caused by
- 28 nonnatural or human activity.
- 29 Section 5. Powers of the department.
- 30 The department shall ensure compliance with this act and

- 1 shall investigate potential violations of this act based upon
- 2 information received from homeowners, insurers and other sources
- 3 the department deems necessary.
- 4 Section 6. Enforcement.
- 5 Upon departmental determination of a violation of this act,
- 6 the department shall notify the homeowner and the insurer of the
- 7 department's finding. The notice shall specify the nature of the
- 8 violation and a remedy as determined by the department.
- 9 Section 7. Penalties.
- 10 A violation of this act shall also be a violation of the act
- 11 of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), known as the Unfair
- 12 Insurance Practices Act.
- 13 Section 8. Retroactivity.
- 14 The provisions of this act shall apply to policies and
- 15 endorsements issued or executed after the effective date of this
- 16 section that offer earthquake insurance for naturally occurring
- 17 events.
- 18 Section 9. Effective date.
- 19 This act shall take effect immediately.
