## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2016 as "Campus Fire Safety Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Recent student-related housing fires in Pennsylvania
- 4 and other colleges and universities across the country have
- 5 tragically cut short the lives of some of the youth of this
- 6 nation; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Since January 2000, at least 170 people, including
- 8 students, parents and children have died in campus-related
- 9 fires; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Approximately 87% of these deaths have occurred in
- 11 off-campus occupancies; and
- 12 WHEREAS, A majority of the students across the nation live in
- 13 off-campus occupancies; and
- 14 WHEREAS, A number of fatal fires have occurred in buildings
- 15 where the fire safety systems have been compromised or disabled

- 1 by the occupants; and
- 2 WHEREAS, It is recognized that automatic fire alarm systems
- 3 and smoke alarms provide the necessary early warning of a fire
- 4 to occupants and the fire department so that appropriate action
- 5 can be taken; and
- 6 WHEREAS, It is recognized that automatic fire sprinkler
- 7 systems are a highly effective method of controlling or
- 8 extinguishing a fire in its early stages, protecting the lives
- 9 of the building's occupants; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Many students are living in off-campus occupancies,
- 11 Greek housing and residence halls that are not adequately
- 12 protected with automatic fire sprinkler systems and automatic
- 13 fire alarm systems or adequate smoke alarms; and
- 14 WHEREAS, It is recognized that fire safety education is an
- 15 effective method of reducing the occurrence of fires and
- 16 reducing the resulting loss of life and property damage; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Students are not routinely receiving effective fire
- 18 safety education throughout their college careers; and
- 19 WHEREAS, It is vital to educate the nation's future
- 20 generation about the importance of fire safety behavior so that
- 21 these behaviors can help to ensure students' safety during their
- 22 college years and beyond; and
- 23 WHEREAS, By developing a generation of fire-safe adults,
- 24 future loss of life from fires can be significantly reduced;
- 25 therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 27 month of September 2016 as "Campus Fire Safety Awareness Month"
- 28 in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage
- 30 colleges, universities and municipalities across this

- 1 Commonwealth to provide fire safety education to all students
- 2 during September and throughout the academic year; and be it
- 3 further
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage
- 5 colleges, universities and municipalities to evaluate the level
- 6 of fire safety being provided in both on-campus and off-campus
- 7 student housing and take the necessary steps to ensure fire-safe
- 8 living environments through fire safety education, installation
- 9 of fire suppression and detection systems and smoke alarms and
- 10 the development and enforcement of applicable codes relating to
- 11 fire safety.
