A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of November 2016 as "Commonwealth Hunters
2 Recognition Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has a rich history of hunting and
4 trapping that has spanned generations; and

5 WHEREAS, The official State animal of this Commonwealth is
6 the whitetail deer; and

7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has the most registered deer hunters in
8 this country; and

9 WHEREAS, Common game species in Pennsylvania are deer,
10 rabbit, pheasant, ruffed grouse, bear, squirrel and waterfowl;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, A recent report found that all hunting-related
13 activities in Pennsylvania accounted for nearly \$1 billion in
14 retail sales, with over \$600 million of that being from deer
15 hunting alone; and

1 WHEREAS, The purpose of "Commonwealth Hunters Recognition
2 Month" is to recognize the nearly 1 million deer hunters in
3 Pennsylvania, to bring awareness to the importance of hunting
4 and trapping in Pennsylvania and to educate individuals in
5 Pennsylvania about safe and responsible hunting; therefore be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
7 month of November 2016 as "Commonwealth Hunters Recognition
8 Month" in Pennsylvania.
