AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), entitled,
- as amended, "An act providing for the payment of death
- benefits to the surviving spouse or children or parents of
- firefighters, ambulance service or rescue squad members, law
- enforcement officers or National Guard members who die as a
- result of the performance of their duties," providing for the
- 7 payment of death benefits.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 1(a) of the act of June 24, 1976
- 11 (P.L.424, No.101), referred to as the Emergency and Law
- 12 Enforcement Personnel Death Benefits Act, amended October 9,
- 13 2009 (P.L.588, No.51), is amended to read:
- 14 Section 1. (a) In the event a law enforcement officer,
- 15 ambulance service or rescue squad member, firefighter, certified
- 16 hazardous material response team member or National Guard member
- 17 dies as a result of the performance of his duties, [such
- 18 political subdivision, Commonwealth agency or, in the case of
- 19 National Guard members, the Adjutant General, or, in the case of
- 20 a member of a Commonwealth law enforcement agency, the

- 1 authorized survivor or the agency head, within 90 days from the
- 2 date of death, shall submit certification of such death to the
- 3 Commonwealth.] an application, including a certification of
- 4 death, shall be made to the department within three years of the
- 5 <u>date of such death by any of the following:</u>
- 6 (1) A political subdivision.
- 7 (2) A Commonwealth agency.
- 8 (3) In the case of National Guard members, the Adjutant
- 9 <u>General.</u>
- 10 (4) In the case of a member of a Commonwealth law
- 11 <u>enforcement agency</u>, the agency head.
- 12 (5) In the case of a campus police officer, the university
- 13 <u>or college president.</u>
- 14 (6) Any survivor eligible for payment of benefits under this
- 15 act, or individual authorized to act on the survivor's behalf.
- 16 * * *
- 17 Section 2. The definition of "firefighter, ambulance service
- 18 or rescue squad member or law enforcement officer" in section 2
- 19 of the act, amended October 6, 2005 (P.L.319, No.59), is amended
- 20 and the section is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 21 Section 2. The following words and phrases when used in this
- 22 act shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless
- 23 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 24 * * *
- 25 "Department." The Department of General Services of the
- 26 Commonwealth.
- 27 "Firefighter, ambulance service or rescue squad member or law
- 28 enforcement officer" means a firefighter; a member of a
- 29 volunteer fire company; a member of an ambulance service or
- 30 rescue squad; a peace officer as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 501

- 1 (relating to definitions); a public servant concerned in
- 2 official detention as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 5121 (relating to
- 3 escape); an officer or employee of a State correctional
- 4 institution; guards or employees of county jails and prisons;
- 5 campus police as defined in section 2416.1(d) of the act of
- 6 April 9, 1929 (P.L.117, No.175), known as The Administrative
- 7 Code of 1929, or campus police as defined in section 2001-A(20)
- 8 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the
- 9 <u>Public School Code of 1949;</u> or any other law enforcement officer
- 10 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or of any political
- 11 subdivision thereof.

- 13 Section 3. The amendment of section 1(a) of the act shall
- 14 apply to an individual whose date of death occurs before, on or
- 15 after the effective date of this section.
- 16 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
