## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in school health services, providing for parent educational information regarding eating disorders.

  The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
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- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 12 section to read:
- 13 <u>Section 1425. Parent Educational Information Regarding</u>
- 14 Eating Disorders. -- (a) Each school board shall annually provide
- 15 parent educational information regarding eating disorders for
- 16 pupils in grades five (5) through twelve (12). Such information
- 17 shall be consistent with guidelines established by the
- 18 Department of Education under subsection (b).
- 19 (b) The Department of Education, in conjunction with the
- 20 Department of Health, shall develop and implement guidelines for

- 1 providing parent educational information regarding eating
- 2 <u>disorders. The policies shall be developed with input from</u>
- 3 organizations and entities including local school boards, school
- 4 <u>superintendents, the National Eating Disorders Association, the</u>
- 5 Pennsylvania Association of School Nurses and Practitioners, the
- 6 Pennsylvania Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics, the
- 7 Pennsylvania Academy of Family Physicians, the International
- 8 Association of Eating Disorders Professionals Foundation and the
- 9 Academy for Eating Disorders. In doing so, the Department of
- 10 Education and the Department of Health shall identify and
- 11 <u>develop appropriate additions or revisions to the Commonwealth's</u>
- 12 school health regulations related to development of parent
- 13 <u>educational information</u>, including guidance regarding the clear
- 14 delineation of such health information from other administrative
- 15 documentation. The guidelines developed for local school boards
- 16 <u>under this section shall include:</u>
- 17 (1) the optional development of an eating disorder screening
- 18 program;
- 19 (2) specification of training needs and requirements for
- 20 personnel and volunteers;
- 21 (3) appropriate opt-out and exemption procedures; and
- 22 (4) parental notification procedures for positive
- 23 indications of an eating disorder.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
