AN ACT

Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in fishing licenses, further providing for disabled 2 veterans and former prisoners of war and providing for 3 veterans. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2707(a)(2) and (c) of Title 30 of the 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 8 § 2707. Disabled veterans and former prisoners of war. 10 General rule for disabled veterans. --11 (2) Any disabled veteran who has a disability incurred 12 13 in any war or armed conflict and possesses a disability rating between [60%] 1% and 99% as certified by the United 14 15 States Department of Veterans Affairs and who meets the 16 qualifications of section 2701 shall be issued a resident 17 fishing license at the cost of \$1 upon application to the

commission or a county treasurer. An application submitted by

- a disabled veteran shall, in addition to any information
- 2 required under section 2701, contain a statement that the
- 3 applicant is a war or armed conflict veteran and that the
- 4 qualifying disability was service incurred. The issuing agent
- 5 or the commission may require the production of the discharge
- 6 papers of the applicant.

- 8 (c) Home rule and optional plan counties. -- In a county where
- 9 there is no county treasurer by virtue of a home rule charter or
- 10 optional plan of government, the county official who performs
- 11 the functions of a county treasurer and who has been designated
- 12 an issuing agent by the commission shall issue:
- 13 <u>(1)</u> free and reduced fee resident fishing licenses to
- 14 disabled veterans and reduced fee resident fishing licenses
- to former prisoners of war under this section[.]; and
- 16 <u>(2) reduced fee resident fishing licenses to veterans</u>
- under section 2707.3 (relating to veterans).
- 18 Section 2. Title 30 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 19 § 2707.3. Veterans.
- 20 Any veteran who meets the qualifications of section 2701
- 21 (relating to resident fishing licenses) and who does not qualify
- 22 <u>for a free or reduced fee resident fishing license under any</u>
- 23 other provision of this chapter shall be issued a resident
- 24 <u>fishing license at a cost of \$1 upon application to the</u>
- 25 <u>commission or a county treasurer. The issuing agent or the</u>
- 26 commission shall require, in addition to any information
- 27 required under section 2701, the production of the discharge
- 28 papers of the applicant.
- 29 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
