AN ACT

1 Amending Title 9 (Burial Grounds) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for notice of burial
3 benefits; and imposing a penalty.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 9 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes

12 (a) General rule.--The following persons shall be required
13 to provide information regarding the availability of veterans'
14 burial benefits to a purchaser of funeral merchandise or a
15 burial lot:

16 (1) A licensed funeral director.

17 (2) A funeral entity.

18 (3) A cemetery company.

19 (b) Required information.--At a minimum, information on the
20 following shall be provided:

21 (1) Burial benefits and allowances, flags to be draped
22 over caskets and headstones and markers, as provided under 38
23 U.S.C. Ch. 23 (relating to burial benefits).

24 (2) Burial in national cemeteries as provided under 38
25 U.S.C. § 2402 (relating to persons eligible for interment in
26 national cemeteries).

27 (3) Presidential memorial certificates as provided under
28 38 U.S.C. § 112 (relating to Presidential memorial
29 certificate program).

30 (4) Military funeral honors as provided under 10 U.S.C.

1 § 1491 (relating to funeral honors functions at funerals for
2 veterans).

3 (c) Affidavit.--A funeral director, funeral entity and
4 cemetery company shall require a purchaser to sign an affidavit
5 indicating that the information was supplied prior to the
6 purchase of any funeral merchandise or burial lot.

7 (d) Penalty.--A funeral director or officer of a cemetery
8 company who fails to furnish the required information commits a
9 misdemeanor of the third degree.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
