## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 25, 2015, as "National Medal of Honor Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Medal of Honor is the nation's highest military
- 4 honor and has been bestowed upon fewer than 3,500 individuals
- 5 since its inception; and
- 6 WHEREAS, March 25, 2015, marks the 152nd anniversary of the
- 7 presentation of the first Medal of Honor awards to six men by
- 8 Secretary of War Edwin M. Stanton; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Freedoms Foundation's Medal of Honor Grove in
- 10 Schuylkill Township, Chester County, is the nation's oldest
- 11 memorial site dedicated to Medal of Honor recipients; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Friends of the Medal of Honor Grove (FMHG), a
- 13 nonprofit organization, was created in 2011 to ensure the
- 14 permanent maintenance, improvement and enhancement of the Medal
- 15 of Honor Grove and continues to fulfill that mission to this
- 16 day; and
- 17 WHEREAS, FMHG is acknowledging "National Medal of Honor Day"
- 18 at the Medal of Honor Grove; and

- 1 WHEREAS, It is appropriate to honor the heroic recipients of
- 2 the Medal of Honor; and
- 3 WHEREAS, "National Medal of Honor Day" focuses the efforts of
- 4 national, State and local organizations striving to foster
- 5 public appreciation and recognition of Medal of Honor
- 6 recipients; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize March 25, 2015, as
- 8 "National Medal of Honor Day" in Pennsylvania and call on the
- 9 residents of this Commonwealth to observe the day with
- 10 appropriate ceremonies and activities.
