A RESOLUTION

- Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to study Commonwealth expenditures for salaries and other compensation
- and benefits of members of State boards and commissions.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has enacted a multiplicity of
- 5 statutes that establish a wide variety of independent,
- 6 departmental and advisory boards and commissions; and
- 7 WHEREAS, These boards and commissions play a significant role
- 8 in the administration of State programs and services in the
- 9 areas of transportation, public health, public assistance,
- 10 education, natural resources, labor, law enforcement,
- 11 agriculture, commerce and revenue; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Responsible government requires an examination of
- 13 such boards and commissions to determine if board and commission
- 14 members' salaries and other compensation and benefits are unduly
- 15 costly or provide minimal value in relation to cost for the
- 16 taxpayers of this Commonwealth, particularly in light of current
- 17 economic conditions and budgetary constraints; and
- 18 WHEREAS, A calculation of the costs borne by the Commonwealth

- 1 for the salaries and other compensation and benefits for board
- 2 and commission members is essential for the purposes of
- 3 identifying excessive costs, inconsistencies in compensation
- 4 policies and procedures and cost variations among the various
- 5 boards and commissions; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Senate direct the Legislative Budget and
- 7 Finance Committee to conduct a study of the Commonwealth's
- 8 independent administrative boards and commissions, departmental
- 9 boards and commissions and advisory boards and commissions,
- 10 under 71 Pa.C.S. § 5301(a)(5), (6) and (7), to determine the
- 11 amounts expended by the Commonwealth for salaries and other
- 12 compensation and benefits for the members of the boards and
- 13 commissions; and be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That the study shall include a comprehensive
- 15 listing of Commonwealth expenditures during the previous five
- 16 years for salaries and other compensation, including expense
- 17 reimbursements, benefits and retirement benefits of members of
- 18 the boards and commissions; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 20 report its findings to the Senate within six months of the
- 21 adoption of this resolution.
