5	WHEREAS, Small businesses provide crucial contributions to
6	the nation's economic prosperity and well-being, representing
7	the ideas of hard work, initiative and the resourcefulness that
8	make America great; and
9	WHEREAS, By creating nearly two out of every three new jobs
10	in the United States and employing half of the nation's private
11	sector work force, small businesses truly provide the backbone
12	of our national economy; and
13	WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is proud to benefit from nearly
14	one million small businesses that employ 2.4 million
15	Pennsylvanians, or about half of this Commonwealth's private
16	work force; and

17 WHEREAS, Small businesses play a critical role in this

Commonwealth's economy, accounting for 98.2% of businesses in a
wide variety of industries; and

3 WHEREAS, The top small business industries in this Commonwealth include professional services, scientific and 4 technical services, retail trade and construction; and 5 WHEREAS, In the third quarter of 2015, this Commonwealth's 6 7 economy grew at an annual rate of 2.5%, which was faster than 8 the overall economic growth nationally of 1.9%; and 9 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth saw an increase of 36.7% in 10 minority ownership between 2007 and 2012; and 11 WHEREAS, Small businesses embody what is noteworthy about 12 America, namely that with determination and responsibility, 13 citizens can build a better life for themselves, their loved 14 ones and their communities; and

15 WHEREAS, For more than two centuries, small businesses in the 16 United States have been pillars of communities nationwide and 17 engines of a strong economy, and the innovation of American 18 entrepreneurs has sparked ideas that have changed the course of 19 history for the better; and

20 WHEREAS, The Senate salutes the dedicated entrepreneurs and 21 employees of small businesses and celebrates the ways in which 22 small businesses invigorate the economy of this Commonwealth; 23 therefore be it
