A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the holiday beginning with Rosh Hashanah and
2 concluding with Yom Kippur.

3 WHEREAS, Sundown on Sunday, October 2, 2016, is the beginning
4 of the Jewish New Year, 5777; and

5 WHEREAS, The holiday begins with Rosh Hashanah and concludes
6 with Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, on Wednesday, October 12,
7 2016; and

8 WHEREAS, During this period of the High Holy Days, Jewish
9 residents of this Commonwealth devote 10 days to repentance,
10 asking God for forgiveness for their sins and renewing their
11 commitment to doing that which is right; and

12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has a large and vibrant Jewish
13 community that has made outstanding contributions to this
14 Commonwealth; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Senate join with the Jewish community in
16 celebrating the sound of the shofar, proclaiming the New Year
17 and wishing the Jewish community "L'shanah tovah," a happy and

1 peaceful New Year.
