- 1 Recognizing the holiday beginning with Rosh Hashanah and concluding with Yom Kippur.
- 3 WHEREAS, Sundown on Sunday, October 2, 2016, is the beginning
- 4 of the Jewish New Year, 5777; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The holiday begins with Rosh Hashanah and concludes
- 6 with Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, on Wednesday, October 12,
- 7 2016; and
- 8 WHEREAS, During this period of the High Holy Days, Jewish
- 9 residents of this Commonwealth devote 10 days to repentance,
- 10 asking God for forgiveness for their sins and renewing their
- 11 commitment to doing that which is right; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has a large and vibrant Jewish
- 13 community that has made outstanding contributions to this
- 14 Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the Senate join with the Jewish community in
- 16 celebrating the sound of the shofar, proclaiming the New Year
- 17 and wishing the Jewish community "L'shanah tovah," a happy and
