A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of October 2016 as "Chiropractic Health  
2 and Wellness Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Doctors of chiropractic are primary health care  
4 providers with surgery-free and drug-free "conservative care  
5 first" approaches to health care and public health; and

6 WHEREAS, Doctors of chiropractic have particular expertise in  
7 the prevention, care and rehabilitation of musculoskeletal  
8 injuries and conditions; and

9 WHEREAS, The chiropractic profession, since its founding more  
10 than 100 years ago, promotes musculoskeletal health and overall  
11 wellness by encouraging its patients and the public to maintain  
12 a healthy lifestyle through good nutrition, regular exercise and  
13 restful sleep; and

14 WHEREAS, Doctors of chiropractic recognize through clinical  
15 experience and research that a sedentary lifestyle is  
16 potentially dangerous for joint health, wellness and longevity;

1       WHEREAS, Doctors of chiropractic, through interaction with  
2 patients and the community and in collaboration with other  
3 health care providers, have the opportunity to teach the  
4 importance of regular body movement and the relevance of  
5 musculoskeletal health; and

6       WHEREAS, "Chiropractic Health and Wellness Month" serves as a  
7 reminder to all residents of this Commonwealth that they have  
8 the opportunity to overcome pain through chiropractic therapy  
9 and to become active with the help of chiropractic physicians in  
10 their communities; therefore be it

11       RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of October 2016  
12 as "Chiropractic Health and Wellness Month" in Pennsylvania.
