- 2 ROAD INTERCHANGE, in Fayette County as the Staff Sgt. John P.
- 3 Wanto Vietnam Veteran Exit.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Staff Sqt. John P. Wanto Vietnam Veteran Exit.
- 7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) Staff Sergeant John P. Wanto served with the United
- 10 States Army, A Company, First Battalion, 506th Infantry,
- 11 101st Airborne Division.
- 12 (2) On March 21, 1970, Staff Sergeant Wanto was killed
- in action in Thua Thien Province, Vietnam.
- 14 (b) Designation.--Exit 18 of State Route 43, KNOWN AS THE <--
- 15 SEARIGHTS ROAD INTERCHANGE, in Fayette County is hereby

- 1 designated the Staff Sgt. John P. Wanto Vietnam Veteran Exit.
- 2 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation PENNSYLVANIA <--
- 3 TURNPIKE COMMISSION shall erect and maintain appropriate signs
- 4 displaying the name of the <a href="https://hitto.com/
- 5 highway near the exit.
- 6 Section 2. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
