## AN ACT

16 (16) Any person who is retired and receiving social

security or other pension and whose total annual income does not exceed [\$19,200] <u>\$23,500</u>. Unless the retired person is physically or mentally incapable of driving the vehicle, the retired person shall be the principal driver of the vehicle but may from time to time authorize another person to drive the vehicle in his or her stead.
