AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against the family, 2 further providing for the offense of endangering welfare of 3 children. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 4304(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 4304. Endangering welfare of children. 10 11 (b) Grading. -- [An offense under this section constitutes a 12 misdemeanor of the first degree. However, where there is a 1.3 course of conduct of endangering the welfare of a child, the 14 offense constitutes a felony of the third degree.] 15 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the 16 following apply: (i) An offense under this section constitutes a 17 misdemeanor of the first degree.

4	(iii) If, in the commission of the offense under
