7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. The definition of "telephone solicitation call"
9	in section 2 of the act of December 4, 1996 (P.L.911, No.147),
10	known as the Telemarketer Registration Act, is amended to read:
11	Section 2. Definitions.
12	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
13	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
14	context clearly indicates otherwise:
15	* * *
16	"Telephone solicitation call." A call made to a residential
17	or wireless telephone subscriber for the purpose of soliciting
18	the sale of any consumer goods or services or for the purpose of
19	obtaining information that will or may be used for the direct

solicitation of a sale of consumer goods or services or an
extension of credit for that purpose. The term does not include
a call made to a residential or wireless telephone consumer:

4 (1) In response to an express request of the residential5 or wireless telephone consumer.

6 (2) In reference to an existing debt, contract, payment 7 or performance.

8 (3) With whom the telemarketer has an established 9 business relationship within the past 12 months preceding the 10 call.

(4) On behalf of [an organization granted tax-exempt status under section 501(c)(3), (5) or (8) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 1 et seq.) or] a veterans organization chartered by the Congress of the United States and or its duly appointed foundation.

16 [(5) On behalf of a political candidate or a political 17 party.]

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
