AN ACT

- Designating the apple as the official fruit of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Legislative findings.
- 6 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 7 (1) Apples are grown in every county within this
- 8 Commonwealth.
- 9 (2) Adams County is the State's top apple-producing
- 10 county.
- 11 (3) Pennsylvania is the country's fourth largest
- 12 producer of fresh apples and processed apple products.
- 13 (4) Today, there are more than 21,000 acres of
- 14 Pennsylvania apple orchards.
- 15 (5) Approximately 35% of Pennsylvania's apples are grown
- for fresh market while 65% are used for processed products
- 17 like applesauce, apple cider, apple juice, apple slices and

- 1 more.
- 2 (6) Apples are nutritious and are a good source of
- 3 fiber.
- 4 Section 2. Official designation.
- 5 The apple is designated as the official fruit of the
- 6 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 7 Section 3. Effective date.
- 8 This act shall take effect immediately.
