AN ACT

- Designating the "shelter pet" as the official pet of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 4 WHEREAS, Approximately 65% of all households in the United
- 5 States have a pet; and
- 6 WHEREAS, About 78 million dogs and about 86 million cats are
- 7 owned in the United States; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The growing pet population continues to be a problem
- 9 in this Commonwealth and across the nation, placing an
- 10 increasing strain on local animal shelters; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty
- 12 to Animals estimates there are 13,600 animal shelters across the
- 13 United States; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Approximately 7.6 million companion animals enter
- 15 animal shelters nationwide every year; and
- 16 WHEREAS, An estimated 2.4 million healthy, adoptable cats and
- 17 dogs are euthanized by shelters each year; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Thousands of other dogs and cats are classified as
- 2 unadoptable and euthanized annually for reasons such as illness,
- 3 aggression and owner request; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Nationally, 37% of owned dogs and 46% of owned cats
- 5 are adopted from an animal shelter; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Most shelters perform health examinations and give
- 7 vaccinations to animals when they arrive, and most spay or
- 8 neuter them before being adopted; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Adopting a pet from an animal shelter is less
- 10 expensive than buying a pet at a pet store or through a breeder;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, The number of euthanized animals could be reduced
- 13 dramatically if more people adopted pets instead of buying them.
- 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 15 hereby enacts as follows:
- 16 Section 1. Official State Pet.
- 17 The "shelter pet" is hereby designated as the official pet of
- 18 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 19 Section 2. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
