AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting the use of taxpayer funds for certain contracts.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Short title.
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Prohibited
- 6 Contracts Act.
- 7 Section 2. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 11 "Commonwealth agency." An executive agency, legislative
- 12 agency, judicial agency, independent agency or State-affiliated
- 13 entity.
- "Executive agency."
- 15 (1) Any of the following:
- 16 (i) The Governor and the departments, boards,
- 17 commissions, authorities and other officers and agencies

- of the executive branch.
- 2 (ii) The State Treasurer and the Treasury
- 3 Department.
- 4 (iii) The Auditor General and the Department of the
- 5 Auditor General.
- 6 (iv) The Attorney General and the Office of Attorney
- 7 General.
- 8 (2) The term does not include a judicial agency,
- 9 legislative agency, independent agency, State-affiliated
- 10 entity, State-related institution, political subdivision or
- 11 local, regional or metropolitan transportation authority.
- "Governmental body." A department, authority, commission,
- 13 committee, council, board, bureau, division, service, office,
- 14 officer, administration, legislative body or other establishment
- 15 in the executive, legislative or judicial branch of the
- 16 Commonwealth.
- "Independent agency." A board, commission or other agency or
- 18 officer of the Commonwealth that is not subject to the policy
- 19 supervision and control of the Governor. The term does not
- 20 include an executive agency, judicial agency, legislative
- 21 agency, State-affiliated entity, State-related institution,
- 22 political subdivision or local, regional or metropolitan
- 23 transportation authority.
- "Judicial agency." A court of the Commonwealth or any other
- 25 entity, office or officer of the unified judicial system. The
- 26 term does not include an executive agency, independent agency,
- 27 legislative agency, State-affiliated entity, State-related
- 28 institution, political subdivision or local, regional or
- 29 metropolitan transportation authority.
- 30 "Legislative agency."

- 1 (1) Any of the following:
- 2 (i) The Senate and a member thereof.
- 3 (ii) The House of Representatives and a member
- 4 thereof.
- 5 (iii) Another agency or officer of the General
- 6 Assembly.
- 7 (2) The term does not include an executive agency,
- 8 independent agency, judicial agency, State-affiliated entity,
- 9 State-related institution, political subdivision or local,
- 10 regional or metropolitan transportation authority.
- "Lobbying." As defined in 65 Pa.C.S. § 13A03 (relating to
- 12 definitions).
- "Lobbying firm." As defined in 65 Pa.C.S. § 13A03.
- "Lobbyist." As defined in 65 Pa.C.S. § 13A03. The term shall
- 15 not include an individual exempt from the registration and
- 16 reporting requirements of 65 Pa.C.S. § 13A06(1), (7), (8) or
- 17 (10) (relating to exemption from registration and reporting).
- 18 "Public funds." Money collected, received or held by, for or
- 19 on account of a governmental body.
- "State-affiliated entity." A Commonwealth authority or
- 21 Commonwealth entity. The term includes the Pennsylvania Turnpike
- 22 Commission, the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency, the
- 23 Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board, the Pennsylvania
- 24 Infrastructure Investment Authority, the State Public School
- 25 Building Authority, the Pennsylvania Higher Educational
- 26 Facilities Authority and the State System of Higher Education
- 27 and any member or officer of those entities. The term does not
- 28 include an executive agency, independent agency, legislative
- 29 agency, judicial agency, State-related institution, political
- 30 subdivision or local, regional or metropolitan transportation

- 2 "State-related institution." The Pennsylvania State
- 3 University, the University of Pittsburgh, Lincoln University and
- 4 Temple University.
- 5 Section 3. Prohibited contracts.
- 6 (a) General rule. -- A Commonwealth agency may not enter into
- 7 a contract with, or otherwise expend public funds for the
- 8 services of, a lobbyist or lobbying firm in order to lobby
- 9 another Commonwealth agency.
- 10 (b) Effect.--A contract entered into in violation of this
- 11 section after the effective date of this section shall be void.
- 12 Section 4. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect immediately.
