AN ACT

- 1 Providing for parental rights protection.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Short title.
- 5 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Parental
- 6 Rights Protection Act.
- 7 Section 2. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 9 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Commonwealth agency." Any of the following:
- 12 (1) The Commonwealth, including the Executive Department
- and its boards and commissions.
- 14 (2) An independent administrative department, board or
- 15 commission.
- 16 (3) A public official of an entity listed under
- paragraph (1) or (2), acting under color of State law.

- 1 "Non-Commonwealth agency." A political subdivision,
- 2 municipal authority or any other local government
- 3 instrumentality authorized by law, or a public official thereof
- 4 acting under color of State law.
- 5 Section 3. Parental rights protected.
- 6 (a) General rule. -- The liberty of a parent to direct the
- 7 upbringing, education, care and welfare of the parent's child,
- 8 so long as not causing actual harm, defined as physical harm or
- 9 long-term emotional harm, is a fundamental right.
- 10 (b) Infringement. -- Neither a Commonwealth agency nor a non-
- 11 Commonwealth agency may infringe upon the right under subsection
- 12 (a) without demonstrating by clear and convincing evidence all
- 13 of the following:
- 14 (1) Its governmental interest is compelling.
- 15 (2) Its governmental interest is not otherwise served.
- 16 (3) In infringing upon the right, the Commonwealth
- agency or non-Commonwealth agency has employed the means or
- 18 methods to achieve the compelling governmental interest that
- 19 least infringes upon the right.
- 20 Section 4. Applicability.
- 21 This act shall apply to any State or local law or ordinance
- 22 and the implementation of that law or ordinance, whether
- 23 statutory or otherwise and whether adopted or effective prior to
- 24 or after the effective date of this act. Any law enacted by the
- 25 General Assembly after the effective date of this act shall be
- 26 subject to this act.
- 27 Section 5. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
