## AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the exclusion of 2 veterans' benefit payments from income for Commonwealth 3 4 programs. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 7 Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read: 8 9 CHAPTER 98 10 VETERANS' BENEFIT PAYMENT EXCLUSION

- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 1 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 "Commonwealth program." A program administered by the
- 3 Commonwealth that requires, as a condition for eligibility, the
- 4 inclusion of an individual's income.
- 5 <u>"Veteran." An individual who served in the United States</u>
- 6 Armed Forces, including a reserve component or National Guard,
- 7 and who was discharged from that service under conditions other
- 8 than dishonorable.
- 9 <u>"Veterans' benefit payment." Compensation or payment</u>
- 10 received by a veteran that is directly related to or the result
- 11 of the veteran's service-connected disability as determined by
- 12 <u>the United States Veterans Administration.</u>
- 13 <u>§ 9802. Exclusion.</u>
- 14 (a) General rule. -- One hundred percent of a veterans'
- 15 benefit payment may NOT be included as income for any
- <--

- 16 <u>Commonwealth program.</u>
- 17 (b) Extension to spouses. -- The exclusion under this section
- 18 shall apply to an unmarried surviving spouse upon the death of a
- 19 veteran for any compensation or payment the unmarried surviving
- 20 spouse is entitled to receive.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
