## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, in conduct of elections, further providing for
- application for absentee ballots.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3302(a) of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3302. Application for absentee ballots.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding the provisions of Part IV
- 10 (relating to voter registration) or the act of June 3, 1937
- 11 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code,
- 12 [the following persons] a qualified elector may make application
- 13 for an absentee ballot by sending a letter or other signed
- 14 document to the county board of elections in the county in which
- 15 the person's voting address is located. [:
- 16 (1) A registered elector who is unable to attend the
- 17 polling place on the day of any primary or election because

- 1 of illness or physical disability.
- 2 (2) A registered elector who expects to be absent from
- 3 this Commonwealth or the municipality of residence because
- duties, occupation or business require the elector to be
- 5 elsewhere the day of any primary or election.
- 6 (3) A county employee who cannot vote due to duties
- 7 relating to the conduct of elections.
- 8 (4) A person who will not attend a polling place because
- 9 of an observance of a religious holiday.]

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
