AN ACT

- Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, providing for emergency services provider payment.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Chapter 73 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:

- 15 § 7390. Definitions.
- 16 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 17 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 1 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 "Department." The Department of Conservation and Natural
- 3 Resources of the Commonwealth.
- 4 "Emergency communication center." A facility recognized by
- 5 the State or governing body of a municipality to do all of the
- 6 <u>following:</u>
- 7 (1) Receive emergency calls.
- 8 (2) Determine the appropriate agency, equipment and
- 9 <u>vehicles required to respond to emergency calls.</u>
- 10 (3) Dispatch the appropriate agency, equipment and
- 11 <u>vehicles to the location of the emergency situation, incident</u>
- or event.
- "Emergency services provider." A municipal, public, private
- 14 or nonprofit service whose purpose is to respond to emergency
- 15 situations, incidents or events and provide emergency or
- 16 <u>nonemergency assistance and service to the public. The term</u>
- 17 includes all of the following:
- 18 (1) A hazardous materials response unit, fire service,
- 19 <u>ambulance, heavy and light rescue squad unit, quick response</u>
- 20 unit and other related emergency units used in the normal
- 21 operation of an emergency service.
- 22 (2) A volunteer emergency service.
- 23 "Emergency situation, incident or event." Any of the
- 24 following:
- 25 (1) A disaster.
- 26 (2) Nonemergency calls for medical assistance.
- 27 (3) Any other situation, incident or event that does or
- 28 may present a potential danger and threat to the health and
- 29 safety of members of the public.
- 30 "Municipal emergency services department." A fire

- 1 <u>department</u>, <u>ambulance service or rescue squad established</u>,
- 2 <u>operated and funded by a municipality.</u>
- 3 "Officially recognized dispatch." The dispatch of a
- 4 <u>volunteer emergency services organization by an emergency</u>
- 5 communication center.
- 6 "State-owned land." Land that is owned or leased by or under
- 7 the control of the Department of Conservation and Natural
- 8 Resources.
- 9 "Volunteer ambulance service." The term shall have the same
- 10 meaning given to it in section 7363 (relating to definitions).
- "Volunteer fire company." The term shall have the same
- 12 meaning given to it in section 7363.
- 13 <u>"Volunteer hazardous material response team." A nonprofit</u>
- 14 chartered corporation, association or organization located in
- 15 this Commonwealth whose members are specially trained to respond
- 16 to accidents or situations where hazardous or toxic materials
- 17 are released into the environment.
- 18 "Volunteer rescue squad." A nonprofit chartered corporation,
- 19 <u>association or organization located in this Commonwealth which</u>
- 20 provides rescue service in this Commonwealth.
- 21 § 7391. Payment for emergency services responses.
- 22 (a) General rule. -- The department shall pay an emergency
- 23 <u>services provider \$225 when the department requests emergency</u>
- 24 services from the emergency services provider during an
- 25 emergency situation, incident or event on State-owned land, and
- 26 the emergency services provider responds to the request.
- 27 (b) Procedures. -- The department shall develop:
- 28 (1) procedures regarding requests to emergency services
- 29 <u>providers for emergency services during an emergency</u>
- 30 situation, incident or event on State-owned land; and

- 1 (2) notwithstanding subsection (c), procedures regarding
- 2 <u>payment under subsection (a).</u>
- 3 (c) Payment. -- The department shall make payment under
- 4 subsection (a) as follows:
- 5 (1) To the volunteer emergency service organization that
- 6 <u>responded.</u>
- 7 (2) To the municipality, if a municipal emergency
- 8 <u>services department that serves one municipality responded.</u>
- 9 (3) To the municipal emergency services department, if a
- 10 municipal emergency services department that serves more than
- one municipality responded.
- 12 § 7392. Certain municipalities exempt.
- 13 This subchapter shall not apply to an agreement for the
- 14 provision of emergency services entered into between the
- 15 <u>department and an emergency services provider on or before the</u>
- 16 effective date of this section.
- 17 § 7393. Approval of response.
- 18 <u>(a) Prerequisite.--</u>
- 19 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), a volunteer
- 20 emergency services organization that responds to a request
- 21 for emergency services during an emergency situation,
- incident or event on State-owned land from the Pennsylvania
- 23 State Police or local police that has not come through an
- 24 emergency communication center must be approved by an
- 25 <u>emergency communication center prior to responding to the</u>
- 26 special call or request.
- 27 (2) A response to a special call or request from the
- Pennsylvania State Police or local police regardless of
- 29 whether the call or request comes through an emergency
- 30 communication center shall be deemed an officially recognized

- 1 <u>dispatch</u>.
- 2 (b) Duties of emergency communication center. -- Upon
- 3 notification by a volunteer rescue services organization of an
- 4 officially recognized dispatch on State-owned land, the
- 5 <u>emergency communication center shall:</u>
- 6 <u>(1) Approve the response.</u>
- 7 (2) Assign a dispatch number to the volunteer emergency
- 8 <u>services organization.</u>
- 9 <u>(3) Contact the municipal emergency services department,</u>
- organization or person making the request to confirm the
- 11 <u>request.</u>
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
