## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the 2 conduct of the executive and administrative work of the 3 Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers 5 thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal 6 Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, 7 reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain 8 administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 9 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and 10 administrative officers, and of the several administrative 11 departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the 12 salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain 13 other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of 15 all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain 16 17 departments, boards, and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel thoroughbred horse racing and 18 19 harness horse racing activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the disposition of funds from pari-mutuel 20 tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and 21 compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and 22 23 employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be determined," in powers and duties of the Department of 24 Environmental Resources, its officers and departmental and 25 advisory boards and commissions, providing for toll-free 26 27 response telephone number.

- 29 hereby enacts as follows:
- 30 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known

- 1 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a
- 2 section to read:
- 3 <u>Section 1938-A. Toll-free Response Telephone Number.--The</u>
- 4 Department of Environmental Protection shall establish and
- 5 <u>maintain</u>, or cause to be maintained, a toll-free Statewide
- 6 <u>twenty-four-hour-a-day</u>, <u>seven-days-a-week response telephone</u>
- 7 <u>number</u>, 1-855-225-5442 or 1-855-CALL-4GAS, exclusively for the
- 8 reporting of suspected violations of the laws relating to oil
- 9 <u>and gas.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
