| 5 | Section 1. Staff Sgt. Stanley R. Saylor Memorial Highway. |
| 6 | (a) FindingsThe General Assembly finds and declares as |
| 7 | follows: |
| 8 | (1) Staff Sgt. Stanley R. Saylor, a community leader in |
| 9 | Snyder County, was born on December 17, 1916, to William and |
| 10 | Ida Saylor and passed away on October 12, 2011. |
| 11 | (2) On September 8, 1944, Staff Sgt. Saylor, of |
| 12 | Infantry, Headquarters Company, 1st Battalion, 415 Infantry, < |
| 13 | 415TH INFANTRY REGIMENT, 104TH INFANTRY DIVISION, United < |
| 14 | States Army, was awarded the Bronze Star Medal for |
| 15 | meritorious service in connection with military operations in |
| 16 | Belgium, Holland and Germany from October 1944 to May 1945. |

1 (3) During combat with the enemy, Staff Sgt. Saylor 2 performed his duties as communications platoon sergeant in a 3 highly meritorious manner. On one occasion, he personally 4 assumed the responsibility of laying wire across a river 5 following an assault crossing, completing his mission despite 6 enemy fire.

7 (b) Designation.--The section of U.S. Route 522 in Snyder
8 County from the west end of Beavertown Borough to Elm Street in
9 Beaver Springs is designated the Staff Sgt. Stanley R. Saylor
10 Memorial Highway.

11 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and 12 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to 13 traffic in both directions on the highway.

14 Section 2. Effective date.

15 This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
